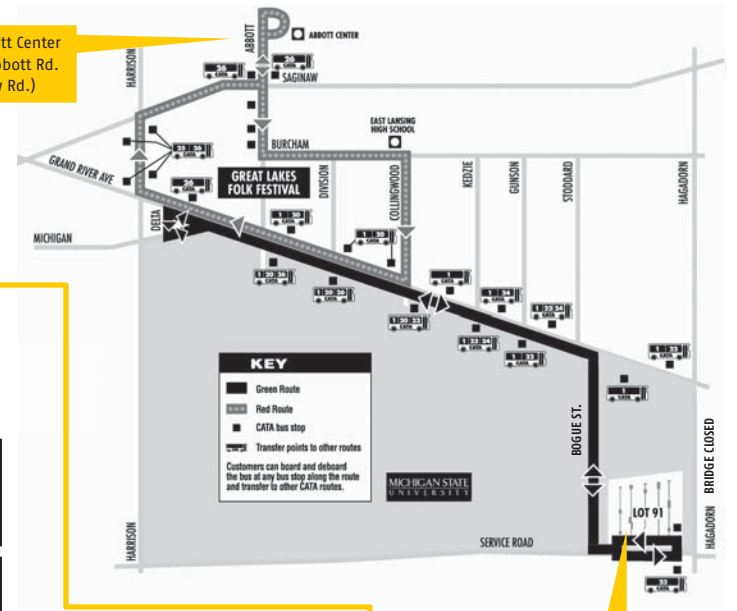


# GREAT LAKES FOLK FESTIVAL

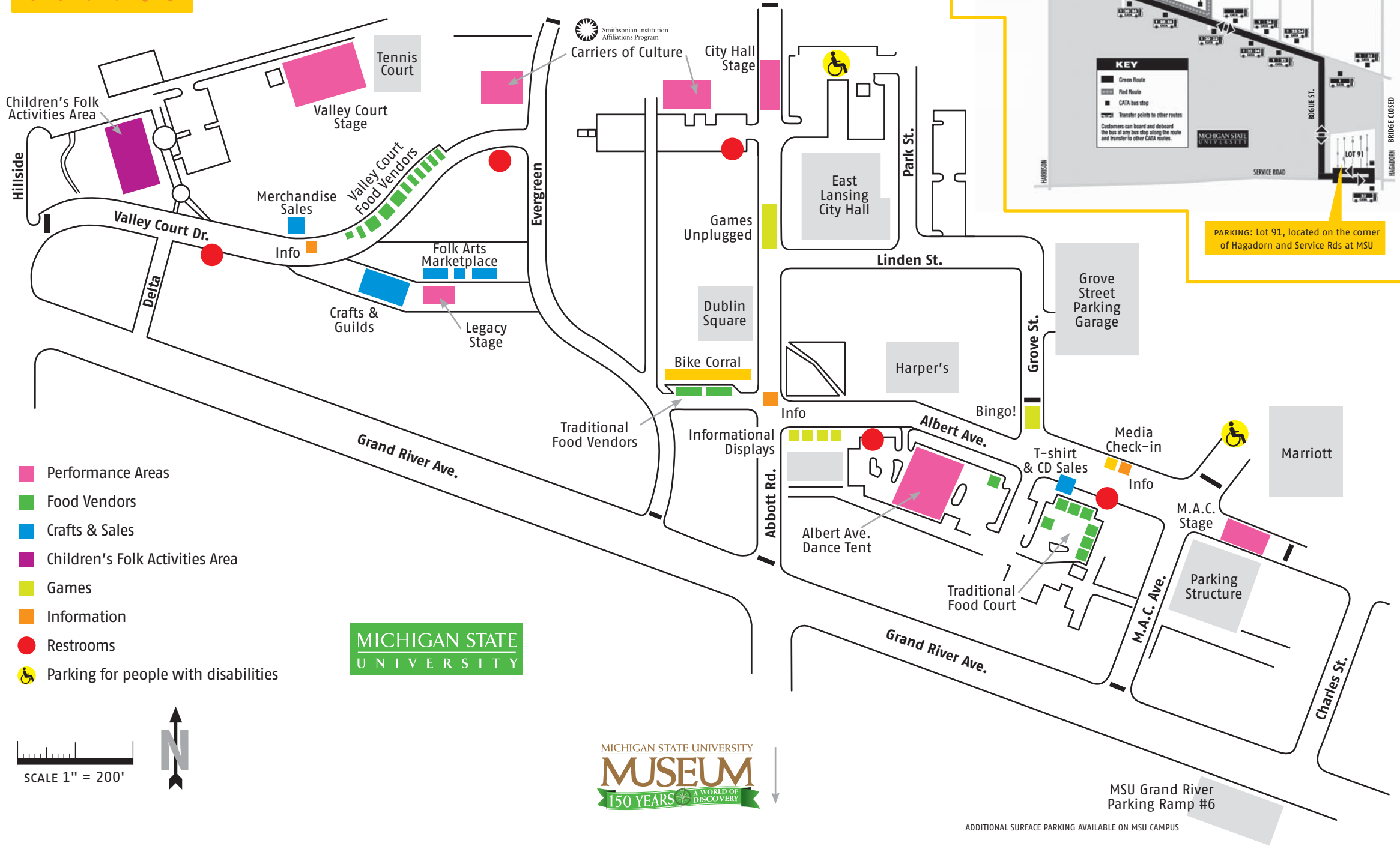


RIDE THE CATA FOLK FESTIVAL ROUTES! Ride for just 50¢ round trip when you board a Great Lakes Folk Festival bus or use your CATA fixed-route bus pass. Children 4'2" or less ride for free. If you pay with cash, you must use exact change. Board and deboard at any CATA bus stop along the routes. Try the convenient park-and-ride lot on Service Road, just west of Hagadorn, on MSU's campus. Buses run approximately every 10 minutes. Transfers to other buses may be made at boarding centers or bus stops along the route. CATA fixed-route transfers are free. Just ask the driver for a transfer ticket when you board your first bus.  
 FRIDAY & SATURDAY: CATA's Entertainment Express trolley connects East Lansing (Marriott) to Lansing (Washington Square), starting at 7:30 p.m.

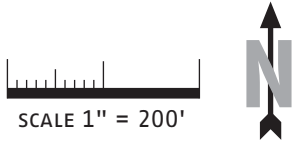
PARKING: Abbott Center
